"No room in the inn" - No doubt you have heard many times before that - "there was ----" Bethlehem was crowded with pilgrims coming to be tated, even as Joseph and Mary. And I suppose that every event that attended the birth and life and ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ, in some ~~form~~ <sup>sense</sup> or other, was ordained of God. It may be that if those folk in Bethlehem had known that the long-promised Messiah of Israel and the Saviour of the world, was to be born in Beth. that night, and had they believed that message, they probably would have provided, for Joseph and Mary and that Babe, the finest apartment that could be found in that City.

If they had believed the story of the Old Books of God they would have known that about that time God's son was to be born in Bethlehem. You remember when the Wise men came to Herod and he asked where the Messiah was to be born, they answered - "In Beth. of Judea". and thus it was written by the Prophets. Then there were many other prophetic ~~truths~~ announcements that in the Old Testament would have told them almost to the day when the Lord Jesus Christ, the Saviour of the world, should be born. But they did not know. They lived lives of careless indifference and for that reason, in Beth. that night, there was no room for the Son of God.

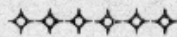

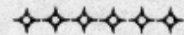
