

## Lutherans, Due Here, Briefed On Seattle

Seattle won't be a strange place to delegates attending the 38th annual convention of the Lutheran Laymen's League here June 26 to 29.

The league's publication, The Lutheran Layman, has been devoted extensive space and numerous pictures to briefing delegates on the city.

More than 2,000 delegates will attend the convention. The league is the lay arm of the Missouri Synod, second-largest Lutheran body in this country.

A highlight of the meeting will be the observance of the 25th anniversary of the founding of "The Lutheran Hour," a weekly broadcast that is a project of the league.

The opening service will be held at 3:30 o'clock June 26 in the First Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Armin Olden, speaker for "The Lutheran Hour," will be the preacher.

Business sessions will be held in the Olympic Hotel. Four resolutions will be introduced to expand the league program. These provide a training program for youth leaders in local congregations, an all-out evangelistic campaign, graduate fellowships for study in fields related to church work, and a plan to utilize the time, talent and experience of retired persons.

## Lutheran Convention To Open Monday

The 1955 biennial convention of the Pacific District of the Evangelical Lutheran Church will be held Monday through Thursday in Trinity Lutheran Church, Parkland, Pierce County.

Ministerial and lay delegates from 106 congregations in Washington, Oregon and Alaska will attend. Presiding will be the Rev. Dr. H. L. Foss, Seattle, district president.

Guest speakers will include the Rev. Dr. Frederick A. Scholtz, Minneapolis, president of the church, and the Rev. Dr. Alvin N. Rogness, president of Lutheran Theological Seminary at St. Paul.

Joint evening meetings will be held Tuesday and Wednesday with delegates to the North-western District of the American Lutheran Church, in session at Pacific Lutheran College. The two Lutheran bodies are among four synods contemplating a merger. The other bodies are the Lutheran Free Church and the United Evangelical Lutheran Church.

## Services Will Show Church Expansion

Church growth and expansion will be reflected in activities here tomorrow.

The Boulevard Park Presbyterian Church, whose membership has increased fourfold in four years, will hold its first service tomorrow in its new building at 1822 S. 128th St.

The Rev. Garth A. Steele will conduct Communion services at 9:30 and 11 o'clock. A reception for new members will be held at the 7:30 o'clock evening service.

The church cost about \$125,000. Mr. Steele, however, estimated that members donated \$30,000 in labor and materials.

The sanctuary will seat 434 persons. A women's parlor, separated from the nave by folding doors, can be opened to accommodate 100 more. A fellowship hall and Sunday-school classrooms are in the basement. An educational unit will be built later.

The old church at 12412 Des Moines Way will be used for Sunday-school and other youth activities. The school has an enrollment of 700 pupils. The church membership numbers 650 persons.

The First Lutheran Church of West Seattle will pass the 1,000-membership mark tomorrow.

Thirty-three members will be received by confirmation and 30 more by membership transfer. The congregation has experienced a 400 per cent membership growth since 1946, the Rev. Norris R. Halvorson, pastor, said. Mr. Halvorson came to the church that year after five years as an Army chaplain.

The congregation also has completed a drive for \$120,000 for a new educational unit to be built next year. The congregation built a \$175,000 church in 1949 at California Avenue and West Dakota Street.

The congregation of the First Baptist Church of Burien will break ground for a new church at 3 o'clock tomorrow at First Avenue South and Southwest 117th Street.

The one-story building will provide space for worship services and Sunday-school classes. Participants in the ground-breaking will include the Rev. Aaron Eirik, home missionary for the Puget Sound Area of the Southern Baptist Convention, and the Rev. Tom Baird, pastor.

Mr. Baird said most of the church will be built by men of the church. He expects the building to be completed by October 1.

The congregation, organized three years ago, meets in the Beverly Park Elementary School, 1127 Third Ave. S.

Two other Southern Baptist congregations will build churches this year. They are the First Baptist Church of White Center and Bethel Baptist Church, Georgetown.

A class of 41 young persons will be confirmed by the Rev. Arnold F. Anderson at the 11 o'clock service tomorrow in the Ballard First Lutheran Church.

Mr. Anderson will preach on "Fight the Good Fight." The class will receive Communion for the first time at 7:30 o'clock tomorrow evening. Other new members also will receive Communion.

Woodland Park Presbyterian Church will conduct baccalaureate services at 11 o'clock June 12 for students graduating from elementary, junior-high and high school and college.

The Rev. Theodore Koopmans will speak on "Facing the Future."

The Rev. Robert Porter, adviser to foreign students at the University of Washington, will preach on "Weight or Wings" at the 11 o'clock service tomorrow in the Bethany Presbyterian Church.

Children's Day will be observed tomorrow in the Fremont Baptist Church.

A program will be held at 9:45 o'clock. The 11 o'clock service will include baptisms, dedication of babies and recognition of graduating seniors.

The Rev. Edward Goodman will speak on "Toward Maturity."

The Rev. Charles Parrott, interim pastor of Ravenna Boulevard Presbyterian Church, will speak at the church's 11 o'clock forenoon and 7:45 o'clock evening services tomorrow.

Miss Margaret Reynolds, interim assistant, will lead Wednesday-evening services during June.

## 2 Indonesian Churchmen To Speak Here

Two Indonesian church leaders will speak at the 11 o'clock forenoon and 7:30 o'clock evening services tomorrow in the Bethel Temple, 2035 Second Ave.

The Rev. H. N. Runkat, of Jakarta, president of the Pentecostal Churches of Indonesia, and the Rev. R. N. Suprpto, a member of the executive committee, will tell of the need for missionaries to Indonesia.

Mr. Runkat and Mr. Suprpto, who represent 500,000 Pentecostals, emphasized that the missionaries are needed to train Indonesians for the ministry.

"Hunger For Gospel" Mr. Runkat said the church has 600 Indonesian missionaries but there is a need for more because "there is hunger for the Gospel."

The ministers told of successful revival campaigns held recently in the island federation. Mr. Suprpto reported he conducted an open-air revival meeting attended by 60,000 persons, many of whom were Moslems.

"There were many converts," Mr. Suprpto said.

The ministers spoke through an interpreter, the Rev. W. V. Patterson, pastor of Bethel Temple. Mr. Patterson formerly was a missionary in Indonesia for eight years.

First Aid 40 Years Ago Bethel Temple, an independent congregation, is known as the Mother Church for the Pentecostal movement in Indonesia. It sent its first missionaries to the islands about 40 years ago.

Mr. Patterson said the missionaries went out to develop a national church, not a branch church. The church, consequently, has become one of the largest Protestant groups in the islands, Mr. Runkat said.

Mr. Runkat and Mrs. Suprpto will remain in this country for several months.
